

Teachme Biz API Access+ Supplemental Terms

These "Teachme Biz API Access+ Plus Supplemental " (hereinafter "these Terms") constitute the "Individual Terms" as defined in Article 2, Paragraph 2 of the Terms of Use for "Teachme Biz" (hereinafter the "Teachme Biz Terms of Use") provided by Studist Corporation (hereinafter the "Company"), and set forth the conditions for use of the API for integration with "Teachme Biz" (hereinafter the "API").

Article 1 (Definitions)

Unless otherwise specified, the definitions of terms used in these Terms shall have the same meanings as those set forth in the Teachme Biz Terms of Use. The "Service" as defined in the Teachme Biz Terms of Use shall include the API.

Article 2 (Regarding These Terms)

- (1) The Company shall provide the API to the Contractor pursuant to these Terms, and the Contractor shall use the API in accordance with these Terms and shall cause its Users to comply with the provisions of these Terms.
- (2) Matters not specified in these Terms shall be governed by the Teachme Biz Terms of Use and other terms and conditions established by the Company.
- (3) In the event of any conflict between the Teachme Biz Terms of Use and these Terms, these Terms shall prevail to the extent related to the use of the API.

Article 3 (Contents of the API)

- (1) The specific contents of the API shall be as displayed on the Service website.
- (2) For the purpose of designing, testing, developing, using, and otherwise performing acts permitted under these Terms with respect to applications integrated via the API (hereinafter the "Integrated Applications"), the Company grants to Contracting Parties a non-exclusive license to use the API and the API specifications provided in connection with the API (hereinafter "API Specifications"). However, Contracting Parties shall use the API in accordance with the methods and purposes described in the API Specifications, and the Company does not grant permission to sell the Integrated Applications to third parties without the Company's prior consent.
- (3) The Company shall issue to the Contractor authentication credentials necessary for use of the API (hereinafter "Authentication Credentials") by a method designated by the Company, and the Contractor may use the API. The Contractor shall bear sole responsibility for the management of Authentication Credentials.
- (4) The Company may impose separately defined restrictions on the use of the API (including, but not limited to, the scope of use of the Integrated Applications, the number of accesses, access time, and displays relating to access), and the Contractor agrees to such restrictions.
- (5) In the event that the Contractor or its Users become aware of, or have reason to suspect, any leakage, disclosure, or falsification of information caused by unauthorized access or other similar incidents in connection with the use of the API or the Integrated Applications, the Contractor or its Users shall immediately report the same to the Company and shall take measures to investigate the cause, implement countermeasures, prevent the spread of damage, and prevent recurrence (hereinafter the "Damage Mitigation Measures"). In such cases, the Company may restrict or

suspend use of the API until sufficient countermeasures and Damage Mitigation Measures have been implemented.

- (6) If the Company deems it operationally necessary, the Company may impose certain restrictions on the Users' use of the API (such as limits on the number of accesses and access time to the API, restrictions on access to URLs for the API, and restrictions on access to the Company's intellectual property rights).

Article 4 (Management of Authentication Credentials)

- (1) Authentication Credentials necessary for use of the API shall be granted by the Contractor to its Users pursuant to the method and conditions of use established by the Company.
- (2) Authentication Credentials shall be included in the IDs, etc. as defined in Article 5 of the Teachme Biz Terms of Use, and Articles 10 and 11 of the Teachme Biz Terms of Use shall apply.

Article 5 (API Usage Fees)

- (1) The usage fees for the API (hereinafter "Usage Fees") shall be as set forth in the quotation individually presented by the Company.
- (2) In the event that the Contractor's number of API accesses or data transfer volume, etc. exceeds the Company's anticipated standard and there is a risk of interfering with the provision of the API to other contractors, the Company may, after providing prior notice to the Contractor, impose additional charges or require the conclusion of a separate agreement.
- (3) Article 13 of the Teachme Biz Terms of Use shall apply to the Usage Fees for the API.

Article 6 (Disclaimer of Warranties and Limitation of Liability)

- (1) The Company shall provide the API on an "as-is" basis, and shall not be liable for any damages incurred by the Contractor arising from the addition or modification of the contents of the API, or the suspension or termination of the API.
- (2) The Company shall bear no liability for any leakage or other disclosure of information, including the Contractor's content, occurring on the Integrated Applications or services provided by third parties (including the Contractor's servers, etc.). In the event that the Company receives a claim from a third party for such reason, the Contractor shall indemnify and hold harmless the Company for such damages.
- (3) Article 16 of the Teachme Biz Terms of Use shall apply to disclaimers of warranties and limitations of liability.

Article 7 (Prohibited Acts)

- (1) Contracting Parties shall not engage in any of the following acts in connection with their use of the API:
 - (1) Acts of falsifying the API or API Specifications or impairing their integrity;
 - (2) Acts of selling, lending, transferring, leasing, or sublicensing the right to use the API, Authentication Credentials, API access rights, or any other related rights to third parties without the Company's prior consent;
 - (3) Acts of disclosing confidential technical information related to the API;

- (4) Acts of making excessive access or attacks, regardless of intent;
 - (5) Acts of using information obtained via the API for purposes other than use within the Integrated Applications;
 - (6) Acts of accessing the API or acquiring information through scraping or other similar means beyond the intended purpose of use of the API;
 - (7) Acts of reproducing the API or transferring or sublicensing it to third parties.
- (2) In addition to the acts set forth in the preceding paragraph, Article 17 of the Teachme Biz Terms of Use shall apply to prohibited acts.

Article 8 (Press Releases)

In the event that the Contractor intends to issue a press release regarding integration with the API pursuant to this Agreement, the Contractor shall notify the Company in advance of the timing and content thereof and obtain the Company's prior consent.

Article 9 (Amendments to These Terms)

- (1) The Company may amend the contents of these Terms in accordance with the amendment procedures set forth in the Teachme Biz Terms of Use.
- (2) The Company shall notify the Contractor of the amended content and effective date of these Terms by the method prescribed by the Company, or shall display the same on the Company's website. If the Contractor uses the API on or after the effective date, the Contractor shall be deemed to have consented to the amended Terms.

Effective as of April 2, 2026
